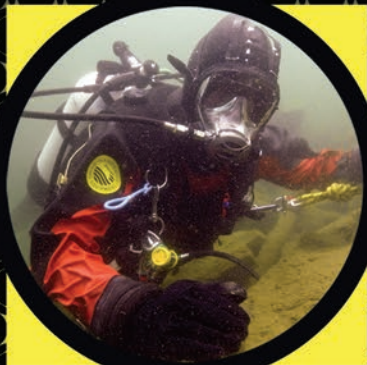

PADI Public Safety Diver Course

The PADI Public Safety Diver course familiarizes divers with the skills, knowledge, planning, organization, procedures, techniques and hazards of public safety diving. It establishes a solid public safety diving foundation and includes basic rescue skills (both surface and underwater), knot tying, arc search techniques, victim recovery, tender responsibilities, communications and rescue techniques for a distressed public safety diver.

Prerequisites:

- PADI Advanced Open Water Diver certification (or qualifying certification from another organization)
- 18 years old
- PADI Rescue Diver certification (or qualifying certification) is an exit requirement

Duration: Three days with a maximum of three dives per day.

Course fees include all diver materials, diploma and PADI Public Safety Diver certification card.



PADI Public Safety Diver Surface Support Specialist Course

The PADI Public Safety Diver Surface Support Specialist Course is run in conjunction with the PADI Public Safety Diver Course. It involves hands on training to familiarize public safety support staff with the skills, knowledge and techniques needed to support divers during a public safety operation. Participants will be exposed to the use of special procedures, equipment, scene handling, communication procedures, basic public safety diving search and rescue techniques, emergency procedures and documentation requirements.

Prerequisites:

- (No diving experience required. Open to non-divers)
- Affiliation OR employment with a public safety dive team
- EFR Primary and Secondary Care (or qualifying CPR and first aid) training within the past 24 months

Duration: Three days.

Course fees include all student materials, diploma and PADI Public Safety Diver Surface Support Specialist certification card.

PADI Underwater Criminal Investigator Course

This course gives you the knowledge, skills and abilities you'll need to succeed as a professional underwater criminal investigator.

Topics include: Readiness, establishing a crime scene, interviewing, crime scene photography and sketching, communications, medical aspects, search patterns, locating and marking evidence, evidence recovery and preservation, fingerprints, body movement in water, body recovery, chemical and polluted water, light and heavy salvage, vehicle recovery, case preparation, courtroom testimony and more.

Prerequisites:

- PADI Advanced Open Water Diver certification (or qualifying certification from another organization)
- 18 years old
- PADI Public Safety Diver course certification is highly recommended

Duration: Four days with a maximum of three dives per day.

Course fees include all diver materials, diploma and PADI Underwater Criminal Investigator certification card.





PADI Public Safety Diver Instructor Course

This course provides you the background and experience to set up and conduct an effective PSD course. In addition to completing the PADI Public Safety Diver course, participants will review material and equipment needs and use, course scheduling and logistics, and marketing the course.

Prerequisites:

- PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor
- 18 years old
- Completion of the PADI Public Safety Diver course

To obtain the PADI Public Safety Diver Instructor certification, the following exit requirements must be met:

- PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer
- PADI Dry Suit Diver Specialty Instructor
- PADI Full Face Mask Diver Specialty Instructor
- Any three of these PADI Specialty Instructor ratings:
 - Search and Recovery Diver
 - Night Diver
 - Underwater Navigator
 - Emergency Oxygen Provider
 - Limited Visibility Distinctive
- Current Emergency First Response® Instructor (or qualifying rating)
- Medically evaluated and cleared for diving by a physician within 12 months
- Proof of affiliation OR employment with a public safety team (law enforcement, fire fighting, paramedic, EMT, dive rescue team, etc.)
- One year public safety diving experience
- 10 public safety diver missions*
- Proof of Incident Command Training Level 200 (or regional equivalent).

Course fee includes PADI Public Safety Diver Instructor Guide, PADI Public Safety Diver Lesson Guides, and Specialty Instructor Application fee

*Missions may include simulations or dive team exercises

What to bring:

- Full dive equipment including
 - Wet suit or dry suit
 - Hood
 - Gloves
 - Two cylinders
 - Conventional mask or full face mask
 - Two cutting utensils (dive knife & shears)
- Towel
- Chair
- Sunscreen
- Water and food
