Course Description:

The **PADI Public Safety Diver** course familiarizes divers with the skills, knowledge, planning, organization, procedures, techniques, and hazards of public safety diving. It establishes a solid public safety diving foundation. It includes basic rescue skills (both surface and underwater), knot tying, arc search techniques, victim recovery, tender responsibilities, communications, and rescue techniques for a distressed public safety diver.

The **PADI Advanced Public Safety Diver** is the last of the "rescue" oriented courses focusing on away-from-shore rescues and vehicle-related rescues.

Prerequisites:

- PADI Rescue Diver certification (or qualifying certification from another organization)
- 18 years old

What to Bring:

Complete dive equipment, including:

- Wet suit or dry suit
- Hood
- Gloves
- One-Two cylinder/day
- Half-mask or full-face mask
- Two cutting utensils (dive knife, shears, EZcut)
- Flashlight
- Towel
- Chair
- Sunscreen
- Water and food
